

Tip for Week (Oct 29 – Nov 4)

Read this Tip Twice!

As declarer (assuming the opponents are playing standard leads and standard signaling) concealing cards lower than the one that has been led or lower than the one played by your RHO confuses the count plus the meaning of the signal. For instance if LHO leads the ♦4 and you win the ♦A in dummy and right hand opponent plays the ♦5 and you hold ♦K73 play the ♦7 not the ♦3. You can't fool partner (she is dummy) but you might confuse LHO as to whether the ♦5 is a high card or a low card.
